2017 AICP Scholarship Program

The Association of Insurance Compliance Professionals is now accepting applications for three (3) One Thousand Five Hundred Dollar (\$1,500) AICP Scholarships that will be awarded to qualified individuals pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree in Insurance, Actuarial Science, Economics, Finance, Management, Mathematics, Risk Management, Statistics, or a Business related field. To be eligible, a grade point average of at least 3.00 is needed.

Who is eligible for this scholarship?

Any student who has completed their first year and one semester of the second year in an accredited educational institution. Prior recipients are also eligible to reapply.

To apply for the AICP Scholarship submit the following:

- ★ A completed application (<http://www.aicp.net/careercenter/scholarship.cfm>)
- ★ An official transcript of his/her most recent grades or a copy of his/her latest report card, providing that it shows the cumulative grade point average
- ★ A resume noting their academic achievements or involvement in scholastic activities, extracurricular activities, and leadership roles
- ★ A short narrative describing any current and/or future plan to pursue further education or a career in the insurance field
- ★ A letter of recommendation from a teacher, employer, business or civic leader, or member of the clergy

What is the submission deadline?

Submissions must be received no later than **Friday, June 2, 2017**.

Scholarship applicants will be notified by **Saturday, July 15, 2017**. Pending verification of enrollment, payment will be made to the educational institution by **Saturday, August 5, 2017**.
