Photograph, Image and Recording Policy
Approved by Board July 19, 2014**

PURPOSE & AUTHORITY

The Board of Directors (the “Board”) adopts this policy under the authority of the Association of Insurance Compliance Professional’s (“AICP”) Certificate of Incorporation and Bylaws to control the use of photographs, images and recordings.

APPLICABILITY & DEFINITION OF PHOTOS

- a. Photographs, images and recordings include all media and formats.
- b. This policy applies to all photographs, images and recordings taken by AICP members and non-members at AICP events.

USE OF PHOTOGRAPHS, IMAGES AND RECORDINGS

- a. All photographs, images and other recordings of any national or chapter event of the AICP, as well as photographs, images and recordings used in AICP publications, newsletters, websites, and other print or electronic media, may be used by the AICP as it determines in its sole discretion.
- b. Photographs, images and recordings at AICP events identified or identifiable as such, published or distributed in any medium or format, must be appropriate for a professional setting and shall not be used to diminish the reputation of, or embarrass, the AICP, its members or non-members.
- c. Photographs, images and recordings, including those that include alcohol or other intoxicants, illegal substances, revealing clothing and/or embarrassing behavior, that may diminish the reputation or embarrass the AICP, its members and nonmembers shall not be used by or attributed to the AICP.
- d. All items covered by this Policy are considered the AICP’s intellectual property and shall also conform to all other applicable AICP Policies.
